



Race information

SPHK:s LONG DISTANCE COMPETITION March 7 - 11 th 2011

Welcome to a long distance competition over 160 and 300 km in nice environments, bare mountain regions and magnificent forests. Start and finish is at the camping ground in Särna in the middle of Sweden. The race is open for purebred Alaskan malamute, Greenland dogs, Samoyed and Siberian husky.

All participants have to carry all food and equipment necessary for themselves and the dogs to complete the race. There are no depots along the trail. On checkpoints there will be access to water and straw. Help from others during the race is not allowed. There will however be a marked area at the checkpoints where mushers and handlers can socialize.

The racetrack is on marked trails around Särna.

First start is on Monday the 7th of March and the latest finish time is on Friday 11th of March at 12:00.
